CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

The Town's waste contractor, IESI, will pick up live Christmas trees from your curbside on your regular trash day starting on **December 27th**. Undecorated trees picked up at the curb are not recycled. **THIS APPLIES TO CITY RESIDENTS ONLY**. If you wish your live tree to be recycled, there will be a 30 yard open container at Town Hall between **January 6th and January 22nd** for you to drop off your tree. Bring the following with you:

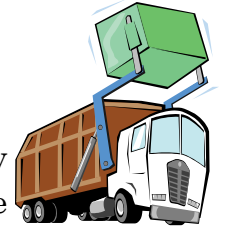
- ◆ Tax information such as W-2, 1099, or 1098

BULKY AND LARGE ITEM WASTE PICKUP

“LAKESIDE RESIDENTS ONLY”



The bulky and large item pickup will be held beginning January 21st .You may put items at your curb no sooner than Saturday, January 17th. You must have your items at your curb no later than Tuesday, January 20th, by dark. The Large item pickup usually takes 5 to 7 days to complete after IESI begins to collect items. Large item pickup is limited to what two men can pick up in a 5 minute period. Be sure to secure items to prevent trash from blowing out onto the road.

WATER DEPARTMENT UPDATE

The Town of Lakeside Water Department personnel will now be readily identifiable to the citizens as they go about their duties. Each employee is wearing a picture ID badge and a blue uniform shirt with the Town of Lakeside Logo and the employees name on it. Now when you see them on the street or if they should come to your door, you will be able to quickly recognize them as city Water Department employees.
