A NOTE FROM THE MAYOR

Highway 199 Update: Lakeside's city limits have expanded. Resulting from this expansion, a large section of state highway 199 is now within the town limits.

Town staff is working with TxDOT to update and/or relocate signs. A new map showing the expanded boundaries is in the works. A preliminary map showing the new boundary is posted on the Town's website. When available, the final version will be posted to the website.

The traffic lights at Roadrunner Circle are now within our limits. Once control of the lights is transferred to our police, response time to any outages is anticipated to be significantly improved.

Also expect to see Lakeside police patrolling the highway, responding to accidents, other traffic related occurrences.

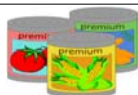
Elections for Mayor & City Council

Lakeside Food & Toy Drive



We had some extremely generous donations this year for our food and toy drive. Starting on November 1st people started dropping off canned goods, non-perishable food items and new toys.

On December 16th our Water Superintendent Craig Bennett hauled 648 pounds of food up to the North Tarrant County Food Bank. We raised 294 more pounds of food this year than last year.



We also received a donation of \$100 from one of our residents to take up to the food bank.

Over 50 new toys were donated to Toys for Tots.

Bulk Trash Pickup on January 18th

Large Item Pickup

Large items may be placed at the curb beginning the Saturday before the large item pickup scheduled for Wednesday. On the large item pickup day, the large items must be out no later than 7 A.M. The items cannot exceed twenty (20) cubic yards in total volume or have any individual item exceeding fifty (50) pounds in weight. These items may include, but shall not be limited to, stoves, refrigerators and HVAC's (with verification that CFC components have been removed by a certified technician), water tanks, water heaters, washing machines, furniture, and similar waste materials. Items that will not be picked up are construction or demolition waste, hazardous waste, tires, dead animals or stable matter.



Trash

Pickup days are Tuesdays & Fridays.

Garbage & Recycling must be at the curb no later than 7:00 A.M. Recycling is picked up on Friday by a separate truck.

*Limit of **6** additional trash bags at curb for pick up each trash day.

Each resident will provide and use containers for trash that securely close in such a manner to prevent the scattering of the contents thereof and to render said containers inaccessible to insects, rodents and other animals. Cans and bags must weight no more than 50 lbs. and be no larger than 30 gallons in size. Items must be placed within six feet of the curb.

Recycling Containers are available at Town Hall.

Brush Pickup

Brush will be picked up at the curb on your normal pickup day if it is cut into four-foot lengths and bundled. Bundles should not exceed 50 pounds in weight.
