A NOTE FROM THE MAYOR

ZIKA/WEST NILE: A briefing from the Tarrant County Health Department informs us that there are 20 confirmed cases of Zika virus across the area. All of these known cases are imported, however this is an increase from 2 months ago. Imported means that the person was traveling to a known Zika area, and then came to the county. They **did not** become infected here.

Prevention: Check the County Health Dept. website for complete prevention information. All of our rain was washing the larva away before hatching. Now that the rain has let up, the mosquito counts are increasing. Small amount of trapped water, such as in the base of outside flower pots are a breeding spot for the mosquitos. The county is recommending homeowners use Mosquito Dunks, available thru local retailers. Card of 6 dunks is about \$10.00. Follow package directions for use. You can break them up for small spaces. These also work on the WEST NILE mosquito. Lakeside participates in County Health Department mosquito trapping program. Please take the recommended precautions for yourself and your family from catching West Nile or Zika.

The form must be mailed or brought in to Town Hall completely filled out with a voided check from the account you want your payment to be drafted from.
