NEW WATER RATES EFFECTIVE JUNE 2013

Water Rate Schedule

Billing where only one user or building is tied to same meter	Inside City Per 100 Cubic Feet	Outside City per 100 Cubic Feet
276—1337 Cubic Feet	\$ 1.60	\$ 1.75
1,338—2,674 Cubic Feet	\$ 2.10	\$ 2.25
2,675—4,010 Cubic Feet	\$ 2.60	\$ 2.75
4,011—Therefore	\$ 3.10	\$ 3.25
Minimum/Base Rate 3/4" Meter	\$ 30.95	\$ 35.95
Minimum/Base Rate 1" Meter	\$ 55.30	\$ 64.71
Minimum/Base Rate 2" Meter	\$ 168.69	\$ 197.36

Billing where more than one user is tied to the same meter is either the 3/4 base rate times X where X is the number of users plus volume charges or if it is larger than 3/4 meter the actual meter size base rate plus volume charges whichever is greater. Ordinance No. 350 passed by City Council on May 9, 2013 that amended the Town's Fee Schedule can be found on the website.

SECURITY ALARM PERMITS

ALL SECURITY ALARM SYSTEMS ARE REQUIRED TO BE PERMITTED AND MUST BE RENEWED ANNUALLY. THE FEE FOR NEW RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL ALARM SYSTEMS IS \$15.00. ANNUAL RENEWAL FEE IS \$10.00. Chesapeake Energy has begun back flushing operations at their well site. This is part of normal operations. Noise is not generally part of this process.
