## **CODERED RAPID EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION**

The Town of Lakeside has contracted with CodeRED, an Ormond Beach, FL based Emergency Communications Network, to provide emergency notification services to the community.

The CodeRED system will serve as the backbone of the Town's emergency planning and communication outreach to both citizens and City personnel by using the system capabilities to send telephone calls, text messages, emails and social media in an effort to effectively inform residents to protect life and property.

When you see the following displayed, you will know the call is from us. If you would like to hear the last message delivered to your phone, simply dial the number back. **"Emergency Notifications 1-866-419-5000 or Emergency Comm."**

The CodeRED system will also be utilized to provide nonemergency community wide announcements of upcoming events and activities.
