Per Town Ordinance 90.24, registrations expire annually on May 31st. **So this would be an excellent time to take care of your puppies and cats.** New this year the **Ft. WORTH ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL** will be here. You can bring you hazardous waste materials and they will dispose of them for you. The Cost is \$47.00. When their container is full, they will leave and not return, so come early if you can. **NO COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS PLEASE.**

MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR



After months of nothing but a concrete tower standing in a field behind the Lakeside Church of God, the town finally has a bowl on top of the Tower. The 300,000 gallon bowl was raised into place on February 21, 2015. The process required hydraulic jacks that raised the bowl in 18 inch lifts. The process took over 3 hours and had to be halted on Friday because of high winds. Now that the bowl is raised to the top it will be permanently mounted to the pedestal. Work has also begun on the water lines necessary to fill the new tank and place it in service. Crews can be seen as they are completing two bores on Confederate Park Road that are necessary to utilize the new tank. Along with the bores on the highway there will also be a new 8" water line laid to the tank and on the Town's connection to the City of Azle water supply in the access road of Jacksboro Hwy. All of these improvements are part of the 2013 infrastructure improvements approved by council.
