## TOWN HALL FOOD DRIVE & TOYS FOR TOTS TOY DRIVE

The Town of Lakeside will be starting the annual food drive for the Tarrant Area Food Bank and collecting new toys for Toys for Tots.

One of the most important parts of the holiday season is giving to those in need. Here in Tarrant County, there are thousands of underprivileged families, children, veterans and homeless that need your help to make it through another year. It's only through the compassion and goodwill of local citizens that keep these organizations going strong, and helps put smiles on the faces of the less-fortunate.

If you want to spread some holiday joy to those in need Lakeside will be collecting non-perishable food items, canned food and new toys items during Town Hall business hours, Mon. - Fri., 7:30am - 4:30pm. Collection will begin Wednesday, November 1st and end on Friday, December 15th.

Last year we had very generous donations to the Tarrant Area Food Bank. We collected 648 pounds of canned goods and non-perishable food items. Let's see if we can collect even more this year!

### The Alliance for Children

On October 19th the Alliance for Children had a ribbon cutting ceremony and open house for their new location at Lakeside Plaza.

Alliance For Children is a children's advocacy center serving all of Tarrant County. Since 1992, over 50,000 children have benefited from Alliance For Children's teamed investigations and coordinated approach. Alliance For Children is a non-profit organization that operates child-friendly centers located in Arlington, Fort Worth, Hurst and now in Lakeside.

Alliance For Children is the only Tarrant County non-profit organization involved directly in the protection from child abuse through coordinated and teamed investigations with law enforcement, Texas Department of Family and Protective Services, Cook Children's Medical Center, and the Tarrant County Criminal District Attorney's Office.

Families are referred to the Alliance for Children program through partners in the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services and local law enforcement agencies. All services are provided at no cost to these families. The goal is to minimize the trauma of the abuse so that children and families can begin to heal.

Alliance for Children has a specially trained team of Family Advocates to help navigate children and their protective family members through the overwhelming process of dealing with a case of child abuse. From initial outcry all the way through prosecution, the Family Advocates are there to help families understand the process and successfully access needed resources in the community.
