After a lengthy discussion, Council suggested a \$1.80 per hour increase for Public Works Water Techs, a \$2.50 per hour increase for Assistant Public Works Director, a \$2.00 increase for the Public Works Director, 5% increase for remaining staff. No additional changes were requested. Staff will incorporate the salary increases to the proposed budget and review with Council at the August 15, 2018 Special Council Meeting (Budget Workshop #2). Council took no action.

Council Member Bill Mohr made a motion to propose an increase in the Tax Rate from \$0.0375 to \$0.0379 and set dates (August 9, 2018 and August 15, 2018) for a public hearing.
