<u>ITEM 1. DISCUSSION/ACTION:</u> Staff to provide brief overview concerning restricting homeowners from short-term rental of homestead. Council may take any action deemed necessary. <u>Mr. Craven discussed the recent court cases involving short-term rentals. Council took no action.</u>

ITEM 2. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Staff to brief and update Council on the Ella Young street light proposal and consider approving an agreement with Oncor to add 15 street lights. Council may take any action deemed necessary. Chief Pitts briefed Council on Oncor's plan to install 15 100-watt high pressure sodium vapor street lights in the Ella Young Addition with no cost to the Town other than electricity use. Council Member Don Pitts made a motion to approve Oncor's plan and authorize Chief Pitts to sign agreement with Oncor. Council Member Bill Mohr seconded the motion. The motion passed 3 for 0 against.

<u>ITEM 3. DISCUSSION/ACTION:</u> Staff to brief Council on the feasibility of enacting an Ordinance to permanently freeze the taxes on homesteads of persons who are disabled or sixty-five or more years of age. Council may take any action deemed necessary. <u>After a lengthy discussion it was suggested Staff schedule a workshop to discuss the matter further. No Action taken.</u>
