VII. **CONSENT AGENDA**

1. Approve minutes from October 11, 2018 Regular Council Meeting. Council Member Bill Mohr made a motion to approve consent agenda. Member Don Pitts seconded the motion. The motion passed 4 for and 0 against.

VIII. **REGULAR AGENDA**

ITEM 1. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Waste Connections of Texas requesting a 2018 rate adjustment, per our contract. The rate request is based on the published Bureau of Labor Standards Consumer Price Index. Council may take any action deemed necessary. Item removed from agenda; no action taken.

ITEM 2. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Council to consider contracting with Dunaway Associates to evaluate participation in the 2019 Tarrant County Community Development Block Grant proposal to replace water lines in the Ella Young addition. Council may take any action deemed necessary. <u>Council Member Don Pitts made a motion to authorize the Town Administrator to sign a contract</u> with Dunaway Associates to assist with grant application. Council Member Bill Mohr seconded the motion. The Motion passed 4 for 0 against.

ITEM 3. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Staff to review construction material bids and provide update on Town Hall construction project. Council may take any action deemed necessary. Chief Pitts provided a list of construction material bids for; Access Control, Doors, Drywall, Electrical, Excavation, Flooring, Framing, Generator, Hardware, HVAC, Insulation, Lumber, Mason, Millwork, Paint and labor, Plumbing, Roofing, Septic and wndows bids. Council Member Bill Mohr made a motion to authorize Chief Pitts to move forward with awarding bids as identified in the bed list, not exceeding \$355,000. Council Member Don Pits seconded the motion. The Motion passed 4 for <u>O against.</u>

ITEM 4. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Staff to update Council on the feasibility of enacting an Ordinance to permanently freeze the taxes on homesteads of persons who are disabled or sixty-five or more years of age. Council may take any action deemed necessary. Staff briefed Council on possible State Legislature action effecting Ad Valorem taxes. Council took no action.

ITEM 5. DISCUSSION/ACTION: Council to consider authorizing the Town Administrator to sign an Inter-local agreement between the City of Lake Worth and the Town of Lakeside for Animal Control Services. Council may take any action deemed necessary. Council Member Bill Mohr made

Council Member Bill Mohr made a motion appointing Jim Minter, as Associate Judge and Renee Culp, as Alternate Judge to the Lakeside Municipal Court of Record. Council Member Don Pitts seconded the motion. The Motion passed 4 for 0 against.
