**Lakeside Town Council Election:** The general election for Town Council has been cancelled.

**Burning in Lakeside:** Now that Spring is upon us and we want to clean up our yards the question has come to our attention about burning small items such as leaves, cut brush or storm damage – tree branches etc. Generally, burning is not allowed in Tarrant County. This does not include your fireplace or backyard fire pit. It does pertain to open air burning.

There are some exceptions. TCEQ can be contacted by calling (817) 588-5800 or going to their website at [www.tceq.state.tx.us](http://www.tceq.state.tx.us). There is a free booklet on the TCEQ website called Outdoor Burning in Texas that furthers explains these rules. If you are granted an exception by TCEQ you will need to bring a copy of the letter to Town Hall.

**Bulk Item Pickup:** The monthly bulk pickup is the third Wednesday of each month and conclude on the following Saturday of each month. Items must be at the curb by 7am. The earliest that you can place your items at the curb will be Saturday before the bulk pickup begins. These items may include, but are not limited to, stoves, refrigerators and HVAC's ( with verification that CFC components have been removed by a certified technician ) water tanks, washing machines, furniture, and similar waste materials other than construction or demolition waste, hazardous waste, tires, dead animals or stable matter. When putting your items out for pickup make sure not to locate it under trees or powerlines or against cable boxes etc.



**Brush Pickup:** Brush will be picked up at the curb on your normal pickup day if it is cut into four-foot lengths and bundled. Bundles should not exceed fifty pounds in weight.

**Household Hazardous Waste:** Lakeside has an agreement with Fort Worth that allows citizens to dispose of household hazardous waste at the Environmental Collection Center located at 6400 Bridge St. The phone number for the ECC is 817-392-3279. Citizens must pick up a voucher from Town Hall to take with them to the center. The fee for the voucher is \$50.
