#### REMINDER - CODERED EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

In the March 2014 newsletter we introduced you to our CodeRED notification system. The system is the backbone of the Town's emergency planning and communication outreach to both citizens and City personnel by using the system capabilities to send telephone calls, text messages, email and social media in an effort to effectively inform residents to protect life and property.

Since its launch the Town has utilized the system to notify residents of water leaks, boil water notices and nonemergency community wide announcements of upcoming events and activities.

Not receiving notifications—Join our database. You can register on our website <u>www.lakesidetexas.us</u> Once the home page pulls up there is a tab to the far right titled CodeRed. Your contact information remains private and will only be used for community notifications. If you do not have access to a computer there is one at Town Hall for public use.
