Officer bond found Mr. White tangled in a thorn patch and hidden from view. Officer Bond cut Mr. White free from the thorns, assisted him out of the wooded area and reunited him with his wife.

MESSAGE FROM MAYOR PATRICK JACOB

Are you aware that the Town of Lakeside gets its water from aquifers beneath the town. This means that Lakeside does not use surface water or water from any of the area lakes.

Just as there is a regional district for the surface water there is a Ground Water District. Ours is the Northern Trinity Groundwater District. Just as the regional Surface Water District attempts to plan for future conditions, so does our groundwater District.

Our District has adopted a set of DFCs (Defined Future Conditions) for our aquifers. Just like surface water, ground water is not a limitless resource. Our recent rains are as important to the groundwater as they are to the area lakes. The DFCs are available from the Groundwater District web site.
