

TOWN OF LAKESIDE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES 9830 CONFEDERATE PARK ROAD LAKESIDE, TX 76108



Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 551 Texas Government Code, <u>NOTICE</u> is hereby given of a Special City Council Meeting of the Town of Lakeside, to be held on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>June 4, 2015 at 6:30 P.M. in the City Hall Council Chamber Room</u>, <u>9830 Confederate Park Road</u>, <u>Lakeside</u>, <u>Texas</u>, <u>76108</u>, for the purpose of considering the following items.
