In February 2016 a Special Council Meeting was held and a Resolution was signed authorizing the sale of Holiday Ranch. Bid Notices were published in March, a bid was accepted by council in April 2016.

A Specific Use Application has been submitted for review at the Planning and Zoning Meeting on February 21st. The Permit application will also be on the agenda for March 9th Council Meeting.

The wedding venue will be called Hidden Gardens, this will be an outdoor venue with rooms available for the wedding party inside. The intent is to keep everything structurally the same and try to restore as much of the original structure as possible.

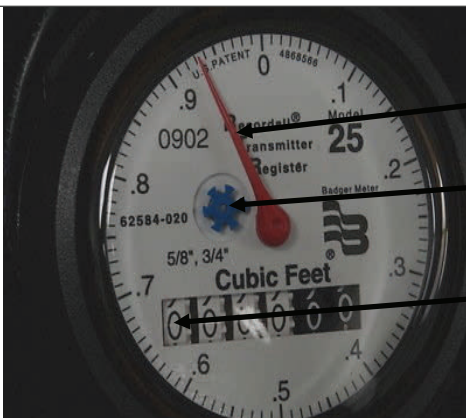

## HOW TO READ YOUR WATER METER



**Sweep Hand**

One Rotation = 1 Cubic Ft  
Water Used - 1 Cubic Ft = 7.48 Gallons

**Leak Indicator** - If no water is being used inside or outside, this indicator should not be moving. If it is rotating, you may have a leak.

**Usage Meter**

1st Digit in black is 1's  
2nd Digit in Black is 10's  
3rd Digit is 100's  
4th Digit is 1000's

**Water Usage Fact = Average**  
Automatic sprinkler systems use 16 GPM per circuit.  
Example : 1 circuit run 20 minutes = 16 \*20 = 320 Gallons / 7.48 = 42.6 cf of water
