ON OF LAKED	Annual Water Conservation Plan Begins Thursday, May 1st						
RCORDORATED 198	 The Town's annual water conservation plan begins Friday, May 1st and ends Thursday, October 1st. You may only water two days each week. This reduces the daily stress on the water production system by almost 40%. The plan is outlined as follows: No property may use water for watering and landscaping purposes at any time on Mondays. No watering is allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day. Hand watering of plants and flowers, not to include grass, is allowed any day during the permitted hours. You have two days each week you can water your lawn, before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m. The schedule is to follow, and is divided according to the last number of your address:
