Lakeside Water Conservation– The Lakeside water conservation plan started on Wednesday August 1st and will end on October 1st. The days you may water are two days each week. No property may use water for watering and landscaping purposes at any time on Mondays. NO watering of any kind is allowed between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day. Hand watering of plants and flowers, not to include lawns, is allowed any day during the permitted hours. If your Address ends in 0 thru 3, you may water Tuesday and Friday. If your Address ends in 4 thru 6, you may water Wednesday and Saturday. If your Address ends in 7 thru 9, you may water Thursday and Sunday.
