QUALIFICATIONS OF OFFICE:

- * Be a United States citizen.
- * Have been a resident of Texas for at least 12 months, as of the filing deadline.
- * Have resided in the city for at least 6 months preceding election day.
- * Be a registered voter.
- * Be 18 years of age or older upon the commencement of the term to be filled at the election.
- * Not have been convicted of a felony for which he or she has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- * Not have been deemed mentally incompetent by a final judgement of court.

The Town of Lakeside has upgraded most water meters to a cellular-based meter reading system. This new system allows water meters to be read remotely using cellular-based technology that will interface directly with the City’s utility billing system; increasing efficiency, improving leak detection, and allowing the City to provide better service to our customers.

The majority of meters have now been equipped with cellular endpoints, allowing you, our utility customer, to monitor your water usage online via “EyeOnWater” - a secure website and Smartphone app that allows you direct and secure access to your water usage data. With these tools, you are now able to view your hourly usage activity and gain greater understanding and control of the amount of water you use. You are also able to establish alerts– including identifying potential leaks.
