Town of Lakeside contracts with CodeRed to provide Emergency Notification Services to the community. The CodeRED system will serve as the backbone of the Town's emergency planning and communications outreach to both citizens and City personnel by using the systems capabilities to send phone calls, text messages emails and social media in an effort to effectively inform residents to protect life and property. CodeRED was selected for it's reliability and accuracy, as well as the system's global use. The Town anticipates using the system to notify residents in specific locations of road closures, drinking water interrup-

tions and other emergencies. All residents living within the Town of Lakeside and those customers of the Town of Lakeside water system living outside the town limits are encouraged to visit the Town's website at www.lakesidetexas.us and click on the CodeRED tab to enroll and provide additional contact information including cell phone numbers, text and email addresses. Public safety officials across the United States have credited CodeRED notifications for many successful events including locating missing children, apprehending wanted criminals and issuing timely evacuations.
