RETIREMENT NEWS!

In December 2021 Police Chief Lee Pitts announced his intent to retire from the Town of Lakeside after 15 years of service. During the January City Council meeting Chief Pitts officially announced his retirement. During the February City Council meeting Steve Carpenter was selected as our new Police Chief. There will be a 4–6-week transition period before Chief Carpenter is sworn in as Police Chief.

Chief Carpenter is a 30-year veteran of the Fort Worth Police Department, retiring in June 2016 as a Captain. Chief Carpenter has commanded the PRO Team, Tactical Investigation Division, East Patrol Division, and Criminal Investigation Division. In July 2016 Chief Carpenter was appointed Assistant Chief of Police with the Lake Worth Police Department.

In March of 2020, Carpenter joined the Lakeside Police Department as a reserve officer providing administrative support to Chief Pitts.

Chief Carpenter has a Master of Arts In Professional Development from Dallas Baptist University; FBI National Academy Class 206; Executive Leadership Development Training and is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force.
