

Mental Health Jail Diversion Center

Update on the Mental Health Jail Diversion Center from Susan Garnett of MHMR. Since the center began operations in early January, nearly 30 people have been served there and provided with additional resources or medical care they might need. On March 3, the facility was opened up to Fort Worth and Arlington. By April, the center should be prepared with additional beds and showers for full capacity. The center, which is a partnership involving the county, JPS, MHMR and law enforcement, was ARPA-Funded and will ultimately help reduce the number of nonviolent, minor incident inmates with behavioral health diagnosed in our county jail.
