

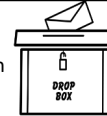

Fireworks Information
 Residents should be aware of the penalties associated with illegal igniting or shooting of fireworks in the city limits. For those citizens wishing to ignite their own fireworks, it is important to remember that the **only** place to legally ignite fireworks is in the **unincorporated areas** of Tarrant County if you own the property, or you receive permission from a property owner in an unincorporated area allowing you to ignite fireworks.
