Waste Connections handles our residential curbside collection for garbage, recycling and bulk pickup for the residents that reside inside the city limits. There will be a price increase starting October 1, 2022. The rate increase will reflect on your October billing that will be due by November 15, 2022. The new monthly fee for garbage on your water bill will be \$20.45 (the break down is \$18.94 plus tax of \$1.51).

Bulk Trash Pickup

Bulk items must be out by 7:00 a.m. on 10/19/2022. Collection will conclude on 10/22/2022. The items can not exceed twenty (20) cubic yards in total volume or have any individual item exceeding fifty (50) pounds in weight.

You may choose to get them more often. Talk to your doctor about your risk for breast cancer, especially if a close family member of yours had breast or ovarian cancer.
