#### **EyeOnWater Water Monitoring**

The majority of water meters have now been equipped with cellular endpoints, allowing you, our utility customer, to monitor your water usage online via "EyeOnWater" - a secure website and smartphone app that allows you direct and secure access to your water usage data. With these tools, you are now able to view your usage activity and gain greater understanding and control of the amount of water you use. You are also able to establish alerts, including identifying potential leaks. To create your personalized online account, visit www.eyeonwater.com/signup or download the free mobile app "EyeOnWater" available through the App Store or Google Play Store. #### **Monthly Bulk Trash Pickup**

Waste Connections will do a monthly bulk pickup for residents that reside inside the city limits of Lakeside. The monthly bulk pickup will be on the third Wednesday of each month and conclude by Saturday. Items must be at the curb no later than 7:00 AM on the third Wednesday. The earliest that you can place your items at the curb will be the Saturday before the Bulk pickup begins. The items can not exceed twenty (20) cubic yards in total volume or have any individual item exceeding fifty (50) pounds in weight. These items may include, but shall not be limited to, stoves, refrigerators and HVAC's (with verification that CFC components have been removed by a certified technician), water tanks, hot water heaters, washing machines, furniture, and similar waste materials other than construction or demolition waste, hazardous waste, tires, dead animals or stable matter. ## 315 Dallas-Fort Worth Total Solar Eclipse Cities & Towns To Experience Totality

Get ready to immerse yourself in the unparalleled vibrancy of the Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex! This magnificent metropolis proudly embraces more than 7.6 million residents who call it home, making it one of the most dynamic and diverse regions in the United States.

Spanning an impressive 9,286 square miles and encompassing 13 counties and 228 cities and towns, the Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is an urban masterpiece. Ranked as the fourth largest region in the country and the fastest growing region in the USA, it is a hub of culture, innovation, endless opportunities and the 2024 Total Solar Eclipse.

The Dallas-Fort Worth Designated Market Area (DMA) comprises 32 counties and is the fifth DMA in the United States, as ranked by Nielsen as of 2023 with a household population of 2,713,380.

DFW is the largest region in the United States to experience the Total Solar Eclipse on April 8, 2024.

# Countdown to Totality: Explore Ideal Locations for the 2024 Eclipse in Tarrant County, TX

It is crucial to use safe Solar Eclipse Glasses that are ISO 12312-2 certified to protect your eyes during a Total Solar Eclipse, except during brief moments of Totality. These special-purpose glasses are designed to block the Sun's harmful rays, allowing safe viewing of the Eclipse. However, during the short period of Totality when the Moon completely (100%) covers the Sun, it is safe to remove the Eclipse glasses to appreciate this awe-inspiring phenomenon without full eye protection. It's important to emphasize that looking at the Sun without proper eye protection, especially outside of Totality, can cause permanent eye damage, so certified Eclipse glasses should be worn diligently before and after this unique phase.
