REPUBLICAN AND DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY RUNOFF ELECTIONS –May 28, 2024

Texas will hold its 2024 runoff elections May 28 to finalize which Democratic and Republican primary candidates will be on the ballot in the November general election. On March 5, 2024, no candidate exceeded 50% of the vote in 32 races, resulting in runoff races between the candidates who came in first and second place. The winner will face the other major party's nominee in that race, as well as possible Libertarian and Green party candidates.
