The curb stops, meters wiring, antennas and meter boxes are the property of the Town of Lakeside. Should you need to connect or disconnect the water, or have any other concern involving the meter box, please contact Town Hall for assistance at 817-237-1234, or after hours at 817-237-1224 press 0 for dispatch. Only the water department personnel may turn the water on/off. The fine for tampering is \$150.00, and this charge will be added to the cost of defective equipment or parts if damage has occurred.
