Texas Commission Environmental Quality

Through guidance from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality(TCEQ) the Town of Lakeside, as well as all cities in Texas, has been observing and inventorying the water service lines within the water system. This includes both the public side and the private side of service lines located around the meter box near the street. The purpose of this is to identify all lead service line material within the water system. Although Lakeside does not occupy lead service line material, this inventory list is required to be submitted to TCEQ and made available to the public. The inventory list will be updated in the future as we are still working to have every service line documented.
