UTILITY BILLING INFORMATION

Create an account to pay your utility bill online at: <https://www.fastgovpay.com/townoflakeside>.

You can also scan the QR code from our website. You will need to make sure the City to Pay is the Town of Lakeside. Once you create an account, you can view your water usage, see your water history, request new service orders and more.

Reminder: Make sure you have updated your old account number to the new account number. You will need this to pay your utility bill and your online banking. If you're on auto draft, then you will not need to update the account number.

Auto draft is always on the 10th of each month, unless it falls on a holiday or weekend. If it falls on a holiday or weekend, then it will auto draft on the next business day.

ROAD CLOSURE

The last year, Lakeridge Rd has experienced excessive passthrough traffic, due to motorists using Silver Creek Rd to Watercress to Lakeridge as a bypass route to avoid Silver Creek and Confederate Park Rd and the Lake Worth 199 construction. With the new traffic light operational at Silver Creek and Confederate Rd, the Lakeside City Council decided to close Lakeridge from Watercress to Confederate Park Rd, in order to evaluate the road conditions, make any necessary repairs and erect signage prohibiting large truck traffic. Lakeridge Rd was not and is not designed to support the volume of traffic we have seen the last year. We expect to reopen Lakeridge Rd, in 90 days or so. Thank you for your patience.
