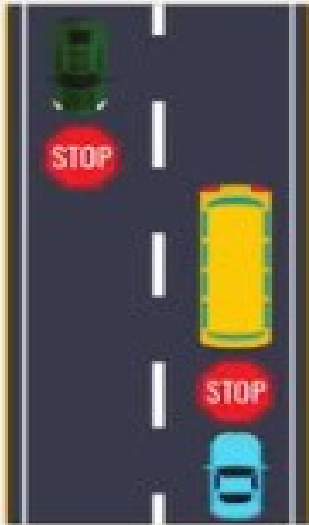

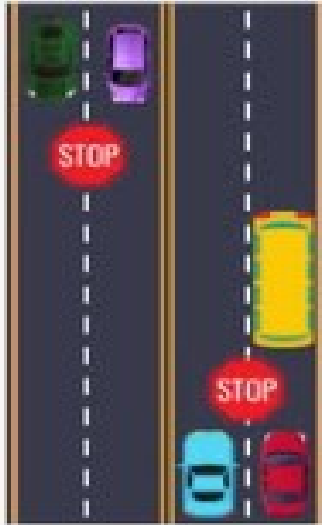
SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

Texas Law | Stopping for a School Bus



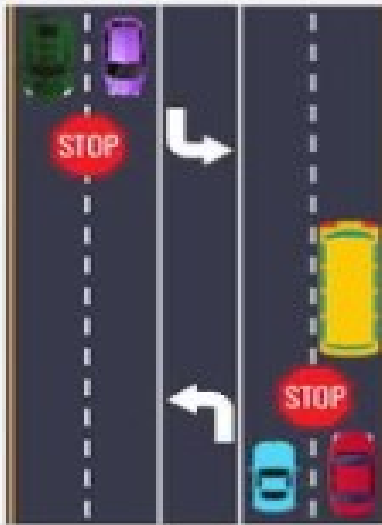
Two-Lane Road

All vehicles traveling BOTH directions MUST STOP.



Multi-Lane Road

All vehicles traveling BOTH directions MUST STOP.



Two-Lane With Turn Lane

All vehicles traveling BOTH directions MUST STOP.



Divided Highway

Only vehicles BEHIND the bus MUST STOP. Opposite direction use caution.

Your patience helps protect children and gives everyone a safer trip to and from school. Slow down, stay alert and know when Texas law requires you to stop!
